

Summer Camp 2010 Application

PWC summer camp will run on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9:30 - 11:00 a.m. from June 15 through August 10, with an End of Camp Party on August 12. Summer Camp meets at parks through out the PWC membership area. PWC Summer Camp is a collaborative effort by *all* families who participate. Families who sign up for PWC Summer Camp will be asked to assist in one or more of the following tasks as explained below. This will ensure that each family gets time to play with and adequately supervise their children.

Craft Helper Teams: Family with registered crafters will be required to oversee at least 2 craft days. (The number may vary depending on the number of registered families with crafters.) You will be paired with the same family for both of your days. Each day, you will need to arrive by 9:15 a.m. Then one of the adults will need to get instructions from the summer camp coordinator, help set up materials and supplies for the craft, help lead and answer questions about the craft, and ensure cleanup of all craft materials and supplies. The other adult will be responsible for watching the children of both families. On the next day you will switch roles. You may request to be paired with a specific family.

Toy or Water Transport: Families with registered non-crafters will be responsible for transporting the box of toys or the water jug on at least 2 days. You will take the toy box or water jug home at the end of one camp day and bring it back at the beginning of the next. The water jug should be emptied out and allowed to air dry. Then before bringing it to camp the next day, it should be filled with chilled water.

We cannot stress enough the importance of participation by all families. This is such a large endeavor and enjoyed by so many, we need to be fair to all involved. Families who fail to show up or find a replacement for their scheduled craft or transport days (barring emergencies) will forfeit participation in any future crafts, and no money will be refunded. You will be given a list of summer camp participants. It will be your responsibility to find a replacement for a day you are unable to make and notify the camp coordinator. It is important to remember that approximately 40 families will be relying on each one of us to do our part. We feel it's a small contribution to help make a great experience for all involved. After all, where else can you get 3 months of summer fun for just \$20?
